Sixth Report of the Pennsylvania Ornithological Records Committee (P.O.R.C.) — June 1995 by Nick Pulcinella, Chairman

This sixth report of the P.O.R.C. covers decisions made from June 1994 to June 1995. During this period, a total of 93 records was reviewed. Of these, 78 were accepted, an acceptance rate of 84%. Of the 78 records accepted, 42% made it to Class I status, a drop from 68% last report and 52% in the fourth report. Two species were added to the Pennsylvania List during this reporting period - Pacific Loon and Gull-billed Tern. This report also contains the second record for Black-bellied Whistling-Duck and Mew Gull and the third record for Barrow's Goldeneye. The first confirmed breeding of Sandhill Crane also appears in this report.

We continue to encourage observers to document their sightings with photographs whenever possible. We also reinforce however, that the primary point of any documentation of a rare bird should be a written description. The photograph and the written description should be used to compliment each other. At times, the committee receives photographs that don't clearly depict the field characteristics needed to clinch the identification, whereas, supporting written documentation may add the missing field marks which at times may be subtle. We urge all observers to send there reports as soon as possible after the event, either directly to P.O.R.C. or through their county compilers. We cannot emphasize enough how important it is to have full details submitted even of well-watched multi-observed rarities, including some that have been seen by hundreds of people. Some of these record fail to get published because everyone thought that somebody else would send in the details. We feel that whenever possible details should be written by the finder(s), rather than by someone who saw the bird later.

During the past year the committee has worked on reviewing the rarity status of all bold-faced and underlined species in the State List and hopes to publish the first revision of the Official State List this year. Twenty-five species have been added to the list since it was first published in 1990.
