# Seventh Report of the Pennsylvania Ornithological Records Committee -(P.O.R.C.) - June 1996

This seventh report of the P.O.R.C. summarizes decisions made from June 1995 to June 1996. During this period 74 records were reviewed. Of these, 56 records of 38 species were accepted, an acceptance rate of 76%. Two new species were added to the Pennsylvania List - Violetgreen Swallow and Northern Wheatear. It also includes the second state record of Green-tailed Towhee. The new records, combined with the recent addition of Bicknell's Thrush, Spotted Towhee, Saltmarsh Sharp-tailed Sparrow, Nelson's Sharp-tailed Sparrow, and Bullock's Oriole as full species by the American Ornithologists' Union (1995), all previously accepted, increase the number of accepted Pennsylvania species to 390.

P.O.R.C. would like to thank those individuals who documented their sightings and submitted them to the Committee. The Committee encourages anyone who observes any of the review species of the Official State List (PB 9:118) or birds not on the State List to submit documentation to P.O.R.C. We continue to encourage observers to document their sightings with photographs or tape recordings whenever possible and to accompany the photograph or recording with written documentation. When written documentation is the only means of identification, we encourage the observer to include as much detail as possible. In addition to details of field marks, information regarding behavior and habitat are also helpful. Sightings can be sent to P.O.R.C. directly or through the various county compilers for Pennsylvania Birds.

At the most recent P.O.R.C. meeting held in June 1996, it was decided that safe field characteristics for separating non-vocal Bicknell's and Gray-cheeked Thrush have not been completely established. Because of this, the committee will only

review for acceptance, sightings of possible Bicknell's Thrush that are submitted with either a tape recording of the song or call notes or those sightings which contain wing chord measurements. We still encourage observers to submit written documentation regarding birds they feel may be Bicknell's Thrush. These records will be archived for future review if new information regarding field separation becomes available. Committee member Steve Feldstein will publish an article in Pa. Birds regarding the most recent data on this identification challenge.

The committee is also working on producing a list of field identifiable forms for which documentation will be requested. The list of review species of the State List is also available from the committee chairman.
