There was a small, dumpy, all white goose with a flock of Canada Geese near Miller's Ponds, between the largest pond and Route 285. I identified it as an immature Ross' Goose. I observed the bird with a spotting scope from the Game Commission parking lot/observation area just before the Miller's Pond turnoff, about 150 yards away from the bird. Because of the bird's jizz (general shape and impression) and size (the entire goose was less than half the length of the body of a nearby Canada Geese) I eliminated Snow Goose.

Its plumage was very white except for its black primary extensions and a dusky smudge on its nape and cap. The legs were short and grayish but not as dark as the Canada Geese. The almost conical beak was less than the width of the bird's head. The color was dark and pinkish. The base of the upper manidible touched the head just below the dark eye. The lower mandible was not noticeable and it did not have a "grin." Its very thick neck, together with its head and beak was less than half the length of the rest of its body. It was very ungooselike, resembling a gull as it stretched to pull grass from scrapes in the snow. Head on it reminded me of a Ptarmigan.

I observered the Ross' Goose from 11:45 to 12:20 when it either flew without me seeing it or it disappeared into one of the folds in the field.
