viewed the bird. We don't know if this is an escape
or what the story is, but this slide is for the
record.

Description - white sides, black chest, white face.

Area - Wild life Management Area

We viewed the goose off and on 1:00 - then
at 3:00 PM. Scope revealed a light colored tag.

Barb Dean

Pentax 8X binoculars

400 mm. lens on camera
200 speed film

Bird spent the entire time feeding.

Sunny in the 60's

4:00 PM to 4:25 PM MARCH 4, 1989

Cosgrove Rd. in Wayne Township. This bird was seen on a reddish bush eating small red berries. This is pasture with a lot of 5' to 6' high bushes. Sycamore trees and Black Willow trees are also in the area and there is a winding small stream running through the pasture. The bird was perhaps 40' away. Then it flew farther back to about 100' away and called 3 times. Picture taken from 100' with 400 mm. lens. Other birds in the same bush and nearby were 6 tree sp. 1 immature white crowned cardinal song sp. Carolina wren. This is the Chuck McAnis property and the road reads Cosgrove on the map but actual signs is the area read Cosgrove Rd. George Dean was with me and we were using Pentax SL binoculars. On 3/5 we took several other birders to the area but could not find the bird.
