This bird appeared 2/28 and was last seem 3/7. Probably the same bird was at Nockamixon State Park 3/12. On the down side, to my knowledge no one ever saw it out of water, so no leg bands could be observed. Although it cannot be ruled out that an escape would wander with the wild geese, another bird with an aviculturist's band is in Buckingham Twp. and has not moved on with the wild geese.
