Species: Eurasian Wigeon (Male)

Date/Time: 27 February 1998. 7:45 AM - 12:15 PM..

Location: York County. Long Arm Reservoir, a few files south of Hanover, PA.


Weather: 38-45 degrees F, clear, calm.

Optics: Bausch & Lomb Elite 8x42 binoculars; Celestron C-5 scope at 48X.

Observation: The bird was at the far side of the Reservoir, but was seen well through scopes from a parking lot on the Grand Valley Road side of the Reservoir. This duck was gray color on the back and sides. The head was rust colored, with a buffy forehead and crown.

Comments: The bird was found and identified 26 February 1998 by Carl Garner, Greencastle, PA. It was seen by a number of other people after I reported it on the PA Birds listserve..


