Snowing to partly sunny, 30 F, some frozen areas.

The bird was seen among American Wigeons and a variety of other dabbling ducks off the nearest point on the left as viewed from the dam. The bird was observed at under 100 yards with a Celestron C5 reflecting telescope at 57x with a 22mm Televue Panoptic eyepiece.

Based on the pale "Mohawk" red head, and otherwise general similarity to the American Wigeons in its company, the observer identified it as a Eurasian Wigeon. The red of the head and the gray of the flanks were clear and unmottled, and the white patch on the wings was larger than the American Wigeon's.
