I'm writing on behalf of PGC Land Managers Steve Bernardi and Scott Bills. 3 American White Pelicans were spotted this morning on Haldeman Island which is located along the Susquehanna River, near the borough of Duncannon, in Dauphin County. Haldeman Island is a restricted access area so please be respectful and obey all posted signage. The birds were present from approx 0700 to 1130 and were no longer there in the afternoon, so be on the lookout in the general area! Last confirmed sighting in the immediate area was May of 2007.
