RARE BIRD REPORT – GREAT CORMORANT (*Phalacrocorax carbo*)
Green Lane Reservoir 4 November 2001 – 8 January 2002

While birding at Walt Road, Green Lane Reservoir on the morning of 4 November, 2001, George Franchois informed me that he had seen a Great Cormorant there a few minutes prior. I joined George and we studied the bird for over 30 minutes as it perched on a rocky peninsula. I concurred that it was indeed a Great Cormorant based on the following.

Weather conditions: sunny, clear, mild

Date and Time: 4 November, 2001 0800-0835 hrs.

Distance from bird: 150 meters

Bird/sun orientation: bird was NW of observers, sun directly behind us

**Equipment**: GAF 8x binoculars, 20-60x scope KFC 7x binoculars, 20x scope

**Description of Bird:** The bird was obviously a cormorant based on its size, shape, bill shape, webbed feet, etc. Back- dark glossy brown/black

Head, neck from above, tail - same color as back.

Bare parts- bill large gray/white in color. Lores-yellow/orange . Legs/feet- dark brown

Throat - white

Neck from below - heavily streaked with medium brown

Belly - white from mid breast to cloacal area

**Comparison with similar species:** Not possible on 4 November, but on subsequent dates (November 8, December 11, 14,15) I was able to view the bird perched on a steel cable with an immature Double-crested Cormorant (*Phalacrocorax auritus*) at the GLR dam breast.

On these occasions I observed that the Great Cormorant was perhaps 10-15% larger than the latter bird. It had an obviously longer, heavier bill than *P. auritus*, and had a white belly (compared with brown on the Double-crested). (See sketches enclosed –2)

The Great Cormorant was last seen on 8 January, 2002 near the GLR dam. (KFC).

I am familiar with Great Cormorants from GLR (May 1997+, and November 27, 2000) In addition, I have seen them numerous times between November and March at Barnegat Light, Manasquan Inlet, and Cape May Point, NJ and Lewes Delaware.
