Received a call from Chuck Chestnut that he was watching
an ad ♀ Anhinga @ CFS. I was able to get there in about
10 min and saw the bird perched in a willow tree on a branch
overhanging the pond. I was about 50-70 yds away. The buffy-
brown throat ^{was prominent} against the black head & belly were very evident.
The bird soon took flight and made many tight circles
over the pond gaining altitude w/ each circle. In flight
the long pointed head, neck & bill were clearly seen along
with the fan-shaped tail & broad wings. The bird
circled for about 5-6 minutes and then when nearly
a speck through binoculars left in a NE direction.
