IN RESPONSE To your Request, here is my discription of the possibil Magnificent Frigatebiad seen by Jim Brett and Myself at Hawk MTN, 9/15/ I first observed the bird flying to The Right of The North Lookout, above

Owlshead. The bird was pretty far away, and flying above several hawks That were migrating through. The lighting was poor overall, and although the outline of the bind was clearly visible, no color could be seen on italall. IT was seen as a gray shape only. I watched it for about 10 seconds befor conceding it was beyond my experience, and pointeditout to Jim Brett. It was observed by The Two ofus for perhaps 40-60 seconds.

The most outstanding feature was the wings. They were very long and pointed, with a very distinct crook at the wrist. My first reaction on seeing the bird was "Peregrive?", as it was evidently a large bird with pointedwings, but the wings were also Ruther Thin, and as I noted had a croot at the wrist. The bird was big (there were hawks in the vicinity to use for size comparison), but the body seemed To have a slight build. Unfortunally, I spent so much Time studying the wings, I didn't pay close attention to the head or the Tail. If the tail were showing bifurcation, I'm CERTAIN I would have noticed it, but I saw no such field mant.

The bind flow some what ervatically. Where as the Raptons amound it were Moving through in a direct line of flight past the lookout, The Mystery bird seemed to be Taking its time, bobbing about erratically before leaving on it's OWN way past the Lookout.

Jim Brett suggested the bird may have been a Frigatebird, and the image I saw that duy was very much like the flight picture of the Magnificent Frisalebia Seen on page 79 of Peterson's Eustern Birds. I have been birding for about 6 years Now, and have no experience with Seabinds, but this bind certainly scemed more AKIN To The Frightebird than Anything else I have encountered in my various birding books. In fact, over the last few weeks I saw an episode on the PBS series "Nature" dealing with Polynesia, and the footage included of a flying Frigatebild was indeed strikingly similar to what I saw that day at Hawk Mountain
