Hi Nick ... my report on the White Ibis:

I observed the bird for approximately 15 minutes from about 5:15-5:30 PM on August 29th. The bird was observed by Joan Bowen for a period of 15-30 minutes prior to my arrival. The bird was perched on a dead snag about 15 feet above the far edge of the pond ... maybe 40 yards away. It was resting and preening. The bird was considerably white underside and white and brown on the back with a down-curved reddish bill. About 15 minutes after I first saw it, it took flight and did not return in the remaining 30 minutes we were there. Hope this is the kind of report you are looking for. Thanks for your work.
