“Swainson’s:-

Tue Aug 13, 1996 at about 8:50 AM E.S.T. about 200' north of PA Rt 183 lookout (Schuylkill/Berks line) there was a light adult Swainson’s Hawk sitting wire in the in the rain vigorously trying to wipe off the water with his feet. He seemed very annoyed but maybe he was enjoying the bath as he kept wiping all over, even putting out his wing & rubbing underneath.

Gyrfalcon:-

Mon. Oct. 28 1996 at 3:15 PM E.S.T. a bird appeared about 50° to 55° altitude east of the north notch at PA. Rt. 183-Schuylkill/Berks line. It flipped & showed all white. As it came toward us it looked like a large white peregrine. Other Gyrs I (Bob) saw appeared first more Goshawk like. But it turned & showed us top & bottom as it passed at about 80° . (very obliging).

All white-now brown flecks even-nice dark wing tips.


