This bird was soaring with a group of ~ 15 broad winged haves and was larger than the broadwings, had longer wings, which tapened to a point, flew with a pronanced diheater, but steady not rocking like a turky where. The bird flapped a few times and had doep fluid wing beats, not stiff like a broad wing, The lighting was poor, so the bird appeared dark overall, After circling with brocalwings it flew in a SW direction ~ 100 above the ridge, but 0.5-75 miles every.

Vewing distance difficult to determine, perhaps one to 1.8 miles. Light poor - overcast with have that Obscured colors. Brisk easterly wind that had pusced many Bu's in to indges. Viewing time short - under a munte? Seen through zeise 10×40's

Bid appeared with bu's but larger, darker and longer winged with strong dibedral - immediate impression, quickly rejected, was of a TV. On orde view, appeared to be a dark, long winged butes. Wings to pered to pointed type. From below, wingtips black with darker trailing edge to grayish / lighter flight feathers. Underwing coverts dark. Small amount of how to cloning visible briefly mean base of underwinde is tail. Otherwise, bird was unforming dark above & below, Looked much darker than BW's. Flapped in the manner of BW's while gaming eift, but always held wings in strong dihedral in soar.

Similar 2009. : TV - smaller headed, wrigtips not founted, but held like spread fingers, deeper blog, rocks, N. Harrier - stammer than this bird with narrow urings, deeper flap, always shows light runnp. This bird chunksien with buteo wrigs, darks runnp. Golden Eogle (I buebly considered it because of dorlaneas of this bird) bigger, does have dihedral but wrigs very broad with spread fingered looks, big head, big body. Dark foropleg - would have shown more light coloring on tail, wrigs held with spread tips, not fornted.
