Small plover, similar in size and shape to Semipalmated Plover. Short stubby bill orange on base with black tip. Pale sandy brown on crown, face, and back. Black on head limited to line across forehead between eyes. Black ring around neck. White underside. Bright orange legs.

walking around and feeding in the mud and shallow water

Separation from similar species (How you eliminated others)

Semipalmated Plover eliminated by much lighter brown color overall and lack of black on face. Rarer Snowy and Wilson's Plovers by bill shape, size, and color.
