Small plover, similar in size and structure to Semipalmated Plover. Short stubby bill all black. Pale sandy brown above, including back, partial ring around neck (broken in front), crown and auriculars. White supercilium, front of face, throat, collar around neck, and underparts. Bright orange legs.

walking around and feeding on mudflats

Separation from similar species (How you eliminated others)

Semipalmated Plover eliminated by paler brown color overall, which also resulted in lower contrast on face. Many Semipalmated Plovers were present to aid comparison, and the Piping Plover was noticeably different from a considerable distance. Rarer Snowy and Wilson's Plover eliminated by leg color and bill shape and size among other differences.
