RE: American Oystercatcher Sighting

On August 18, 1989 I received a report from Mr. Charles Bowen of an American Oystercatcher on the Susquehanna River between Middletown and Three Mile Island. Mr. Bowen produced the following (attached) description. The points of the sighting I would like to add:

- 1. Mr. Bowen is familiar with the species from New Jersey coast.
- 2. His immediate impression was that it was an Oystercatcher.
- 3. He was impressed by or recognized the large bright red/orange bill.
- 4. Rendering:
 - A. Mr. Bowen did indicate head was all black
 - legs were not quite as bright as bill but had definite Β. color (pink-red) to them
 - C. definite sharp line between white & dark (black) regions on body
- 5. The drawing/rendering was discussed before referrals to field guides.
- Positive ID's from field guides by Mr. Bowen after discussion of 6. sighting & - Field guides referred to Master Guide w/photos; National Geo., Golden & Peterson's

As discussed w/Steve Santer this sighting definitely can not merit a #1 or #2 classification but should be recorded as a "possible". I personally am faily well convinced that Mr. Bowen did observe said species and correctly ID'd it.
