Myhusland and I drove into launch area No. 1 at Jake willen at approximately 6:50 PM August 14, 1894. An avocet was standing on the wooden boat launch. It was facing west and looking out over the water.

(lam referring to body eige) I received the brid from 50 feet away to perfore 25 feet away. The bill was long and their. It was also black and perhaps 4" in length. The bill was upturned at the tip. The head and long neck was a pale sust lolor with some pale grey mixed in. I have ensured 3 photographs and I must comment that the chars in the photographs are more exagginated. The bird was paler in color than the photos suggest. The beautiful plackend white pattern on the wings help ID the bird. The under pick of the bird (beley flenks remo) were white (a warm white due to the setting sum.) It doesn't show in the photograph but the hird had a white eye ming. The arrover stood on the western boal launch with its wholed feet barrey overed with water. The legs looked medium to such grey, The bird never fed fort stid call. It

gave out 10 calls. The call was loud and sixeling one note calls — one often the other. Wheet!

Occasionally the bird would stretch its neck and head up and down repeating their 3 or 4 times.

Desturbed by them. I great blue beron stood east of the arrest about 25 feet away in the water.

I remember looking four at my camera to see how much film is had left when my busbond yelled that the bird was flying off. My husband had been standing at a picinic table about 50 feet.
