RUFF GULL POINT, PRESQUE ISLE STATE PARK, ERIE, PENNSYLVANIA Sept. 24, 1989



Larger then a LesseRYellowlegs but smaller than a Greater Yellowlegs.

Head had redish brown cap.

Bird seen as close as ten feet with 7 X 35 binoculars and seen flying. White tail spots well noted. This was at 1:10 P.M. Sunday afternoon. I was alone and the bird not seen again.

Feet were very yellow thicker and shorter than the Yellowlegs with no orangeish coloring.

I did not have a book with me at the time and did not notice the yellow at the base of the bill.

The bird resembled a Buff-breasted Sandpiper in coloring except for the reddish cap.

It was much lighter than a dowitcher and had a longer neck. It looked much like a

very small Willit untill it flew, revieling the tail pattern of the Ruff.

This is the second report of a Ruff from Presque Isle, One was reported seen on

August 9, 1973.
