Description: The bird was larger than the Pectorals and about the size of the L. Yellowlegs but with stockier build. It had a pale buff head, neck, breast, and flanks. The cap and back of the neck were darker due to fine streaking and contrasted with the pale supercilium, darker eye line, and pale cheek. The lower belly and undertail were white. The bill was black with small spot of white feathers at the base. The legs were also darkish and longer than Pectoral's. The feathers of the upperparts were dark, fringed in white or off white.

Similar Species Comparison: Based on the buff color, I think the most likely error of the inexperienced would be to call it a Buff-breasted S. However, it is longer legged, larger, and stockier than that species. Unmarked buff breast among several other characteristics eliminates Upland S., Pectoral S., and both Yellowlegs.
