Surprisingly, the views were excellent in the scope anyway. 11/17 Hazy clouds with sun showing through. Excellent views. OPTICAL EQUIPMENT USED Zeiss 7x42 & Leica APO Trinovid 77 DESCRIPTION (Include as much detail as you observed - size relative to other species present; "jizz" = e.g. posture, body shape, and proportions; colors and patterns of plumage; bill, eye, and leg characteristics; other features relevant to this individual): Gray back, gray extending down the sides between breast and flanks, some paler smudgy gray on flanks. Front of neck and breast white. White forehead extending halfway or more through crown. Rear of crown dark gray extending in a dark strip down back of neck. Dark eyeline/patch upturned at rear. Rest of face and neck white. Dark bill broader than in Red-necked Phalarope. Feet were dark. White wing stripe seen in flight. (Please use an additional page if necessary.) BEHAVIOR (be as detailed as possible about what the bird was doing) Feeding on the mat of water plants. It would fly between feeding spots. At times the bird was actually walking on the mat of plants. **VOCALIZATIONS** High squeaky single note when it took off.
