OBVIOUS WING PATTERN EVEN FROM A FAR DISTANCE, UPPER WING PRIMARIES WELE BLACK WITH INNER PRIMARIES BEING WHITE, UPPER WING COVERTS WERE BROWN AND SECONDARIES WERE ALSO WHITE, THIS PATTERN FORMED A WHITE TRIANGLE IN THE MIDDLE PORTION OF THE WING (SEE DRAWING ATTACHED) THE UPPER TAIL COVERTS WERE A STRINING WHITE WITH A DARK BAND AT THE TIP OF THE TAIL ITSELF.

THE TWO BIRDS WERE TRAVELING WITH 3 LAUGHING GULLS AND WHEN THE LAUGHING CULLS LANDED SO DID THE SABINE'S, THE SAGINE'S GULLS WERE SMALLER THAN THE LAUGHING GULLS, BEING ABOUT THE SIZE OF A BONAPARTO'S FLIGHT WAS BASICALLY A STRAIGHT FORWARD STYLE.
