





Black-headed Gull, Larus ridibundus (Adult) Radcliffe Road Riverfront Parking Lot Bristol, Bucks County, Pennsylvania August 1, 2010 08:50 Overcast conditions, no precipitation

Devich Farbotnik and I made quick scan of gulls standing on a parking lot in Bristol, Bucks County, Pennsylvania. This location borders the Delaware River.

This stop yielded a surprise Black-headed Gull among the relatively small group of RBGU and LAGU.

The BHGU was an adult bird: bright red legs, dark red bill, sharply defined dark brown hood starting to show fade on crown and in areas around base of bill.

Darkest feathers were on the throat, and around the perimeter of the hood.

Dark underside of primary feathers noticeable on preening bird (photo included). Pale gray mantle. Slightly smaller than surrounding LAGU.

A cyclist proceeded to flush the gulls out onto the Delaware River, where we eventually lost track of the BHGU as it headed south. Repeated checks of the river in various locations throughout the day, as well as the parking lot, did not turn up the BHGU.
