Bird was with a flock of Bonaparte's and Ring-billed Gulls. It was smaller than the Bonaparte's. The black underwings stood out dramatically (see photo). No other small gull has black underwings such as this. (Common Black-headed Gull is larger and the underwings are not solid black).

This bird was feeding over farmer's fields away from any significant body of water. A small stream flowed nearby (only a few feet across).


