

Habitat: Large lake

Description (only what you observed; size relative to other species present; posture, body shape & proportions; colors & patterns of plumage; bill, eye, & leg characteristics; other features relevant to this individual): The bird was a juvenile but did not have as much brown on the mantle or wings as the field guides show. I assume it was molting into an adult. Forehead was clean white with black band from eye to back of head with crest. The bill was more yellow than orange but for some reason the photos & video I saw showed the bill more orange than I thought it actually was. Mantle and folded wings were mottled instead of clean gray but not strikingly so with minor darker barring showing on the folded wings. Tail was slightly forked. The under wings were white with darker wing tips. Upper primaries were dark in folded wing and in flight. Some residual dark barring in the wing could be seen in flight and sitting. Legs were dark which again I assume means indicates the bird was advanced toward adult characters.

**Behavior** (Be as specific as possible about what the bird was doing): Sitting on a fishing pier, flying, and diving headfirst catching fish

Separation from Similar Species (How you eliminated others): The Caspian Tern is bulkier, has heavy streaking on the forehead, a more orange/red bill on the juvenile, less forked tail, paler upper wing, and much more extensive black on the under wing. Juv. Elegant Tern does not have the dark wing plumage, and more extensive black cap and crest area, among other points.
