HABITAT (e.g. mowed field, woodland edge, any other details)

Large reservoir with mowed lawn on the side where the Black Skimmer was seen. Opposite side of the reservoir has trees. All bordered by local roads.

DISTANCE TO BIRD from parked car: 100 feet; as he skimmed the water's edge, I was within 10 feet of the bird taking pictures

VIEWING CONDITIONS (sky, weather, position of sun relative to you)

The sky was clear. The weather was bright and sunny. I was facing north to a little bit north-east at times, so the sun was to my back and right (E/SE).

OPTICAL EQUIPMENT USED

CAMERA: <u>Nikon Coolpix4500 Digital Camera.</u> Focal length: 38.2mm; 1/431.7sec. f/7.3; digital zoom 2.60 (For the pictures)

First saw the Black Skimmer using binoculars: Eagle Optics 10X42. First observed: I was on the opposite side of the reservoir (the western edge). Checked with Spotting Scope: Leica Televid APO 77mm; Leica lens 20X - 60X zoom lens. When identified, I moved to the eastern side of the reservoir to observe and take the pictures.

Bird was observed in flight above the reservoir (30 feet above) and also skimming the water's edge.

- 1. **PLUMMAGE:** The solid *Black and white plummage very clear:* Black above/white below/crown of head black/forehead white; NO eyerings or eye lines;
- 2. WINGS: Very long wings: Upper: black with the trailing edge of the secondaries and part of the primaries: white; Lower: primaries black; most of remaining underwing: white
- 3. SIZE: More slender than the Ring-billed gulls present; approx. 20"
- 4. TAIL: Forked
- 5. BILL: Distinct bright red bill, with black tip.
- 6. **BILL**: Observed while skimming within a few feet of me: The lower mandible was a bit longer than the upper: hence the ability to skim the water.

BEHAVIOR (be as detailed as possible about what the bird was doing)

The Black Skimmer was observed flying above the water at 30 feet and then flying low over the water. He would keep circling around the same section and the skim the water. He skimmed the water right by the water's edge, within 10 feet of where I was standing.

Bird observed for 30 minutes(flying and skimming the water) and at 10AM, he flew South/east.

I have observed Black Skimmers in their normal environment of coastal bodies of water.
