Once a chased a WPW from its nest on Staten Island. I could not find the nest. I found a CWW mest in Jasper County, SC. The parents of all these birds were silent.

The call I heard in my garden was **chuck-WILLS-widow.** It called for ~2 minutes. I could not believe it nor mistake it. I have been listening for it since. No luck.
