Eventually bird was singing in my backyard, approx 75 feet from house along hedgerow between yard and adjacent hay field. After a few minutes the bird moved approx 200 feet across the field westward to the next hedgerow. It then moved again, eventually out of hearing. The time within hearing distance was approx 20 minutes.
