

On Saturday October 34 1992 I visited to home in Elk Creek Township, Erie County PA to see an adult of Rufous Hummingbird which was coming to their feeder. The bird approx. every 15 minutes which gave ample apportunity for study. It was a small humming bird with orange-rufous upperparts no billiant copper garget. There was a whitish band across the upper breast underneath the garget. The lower breast and belly were orange but, pales than the upperparts and this color extended down the Harks. The wings o were dark brown and the tail feathers (rectices) were sharply pointed and rupous brown. The most important feature on this bird was the uniform repous - orange martle with no trace of green, separating it from an Allen's Hunningbird.
