**Conditions**: The bird was viewed with 7x42 Zeiss Binoculars and Leica APO77 Zoom Scope. It was a bright sunny day with mild temperatures. It was as close as 20 ft. but most views were at 40 - 50 ft.

**Behavior & Habitat**: Seen perched on high branch, feeding at feeder, and hawking insects at top of tree. Some flowers were still alive including Trumpet Honeysuckle but I didn't see it go to flowers.

**Description**: It was Ruby-throated Hummingbird size with mostly green upper parts except some rufous on the supercilium area. When sitting on the perch in bright sun, it appeared to have rufous on the rump and tail as well but I am not sure this did not show at all in a side view on the video. There also was rufous on the flanks, a white upper breast and lower belly, and throat with dark streaks. It had a depression on its lower throat/upper breast, which in the hand was apparently the result of missing feathers (see below). The folded wing primaries appeared dark. There was white crescent at the eye. Since this was apparently a young bird, the proof of species was obtained by capture and banding by Scott Wiedensaul and this is what he said: "This afternoon I banded an immature male rufous hummingbird, which had just appeared this morning at Babe Webster's house in Pipersville, Bucks County. The bird was feeding regularly at a feeder in Babe's yard despite the pouring rain, and was there at least through 4 p.m., a couple hours after we finished processing it and Babe released it. The hummer has a mostly green back with a lot of rusty flecking, and is missing most of the feathers on its lower throat (which my friend Mary gustafson at the Banding Lab thinks may have been a result of flying into a wire or other obstruction). The presence of a cleft on the R2 tail feather (a feature generally invisible except in the hand) cinched the ID."
