It had 3-toes on the right foot; a ladder book (slightly ruffled); two white peteles on the back of the head, with a few scattered black feathers (or these dark feathers would have been lower barbs of white feathers; about 10 primary wany feathers barred; thin white line through the eye, not connected to the white potalos; black cop, barred sides; and it appeared to have a little sit of yellow (at the base of the lower mondible.
