The following is a brief description of the details surrounding my observation of a Violet-green Swallow:

Marysville, Pa.

On May 10, 1997 between 9:00 and 10:00 am I was standing along the shoreline of the Susquehanna River. I observed a bird through 10X binoculars that was approximately the same size, shape, and color as an adult Tree Swallow from a distance of about 25 meters. This bird had large white flank patches on both sides. The outer third of both sides of the rump was white and the middle third was dark green. This bird was flying approximately 2-3 feet below my eye level and I got an excellent look at its dorsal side. By the time I got on this bird it was flying away from me so I did not get a look at the head pattern. I watched this bird fly upriver for about 8-10 seconds until my view was obstructed by some trees. This bird was distinctly different than the rest of the Tree Swallows which were migrating past by the dozens. The morning was mostly cloudy, if the sun was out it would have been behind me and to my right about 45 degrees.
