Various committee members felt that the details submitted did not conclusively rule out Carolina Wren (in particular there was no reference to the length of the tail). This does not of course mean that the bird was not a Bewick's Wren, merely that the details did not allow for a concrete determination.

We hope that this does not discourage you from submitting documentation on any rare birds you find in the future. Please be encouraged to send as much detail as possible.
