I'm attaching three recordings (and their sonograms) that I think could represent nocturnal calls of migrating Bicknell's Thrushes.

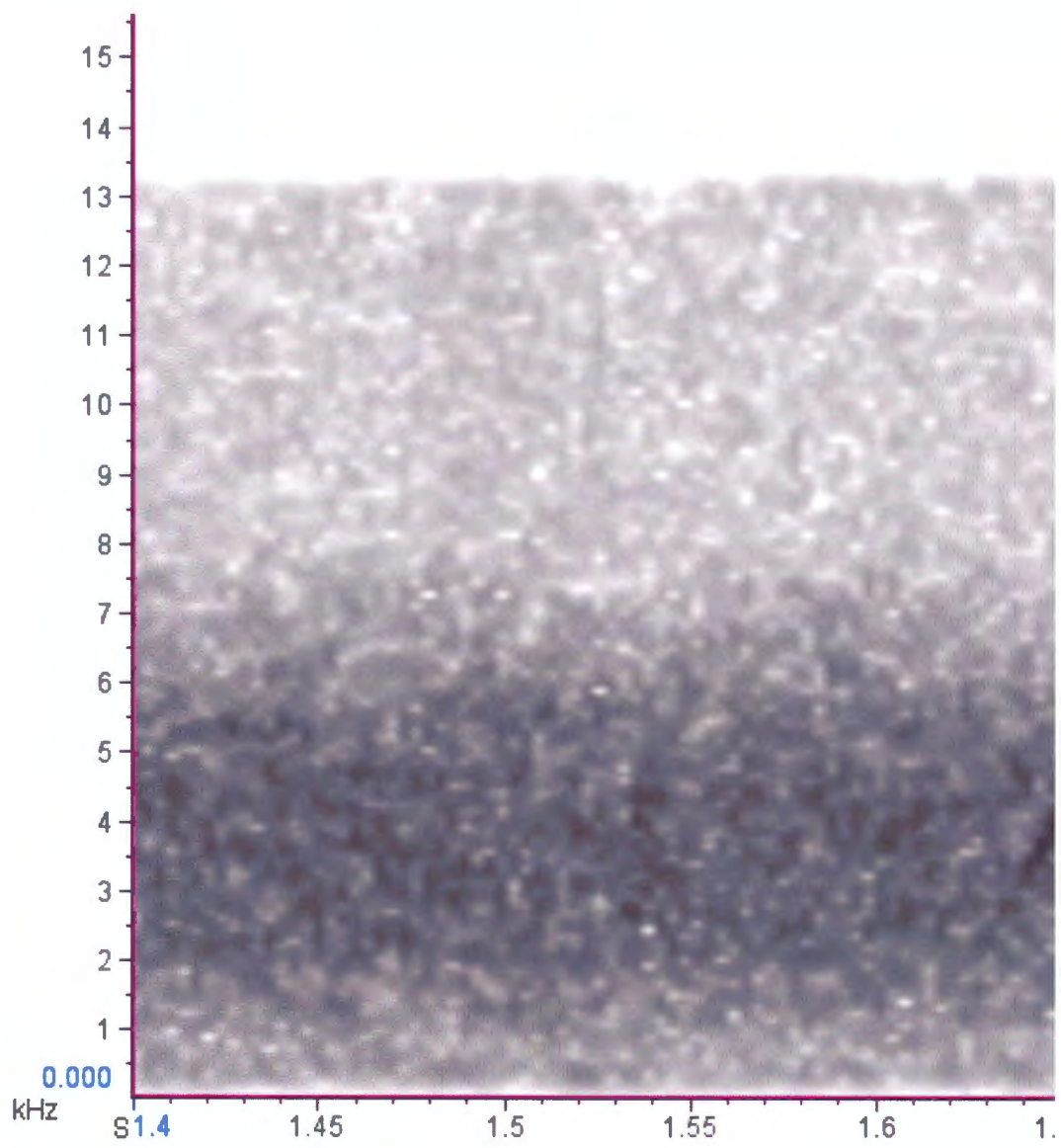
They were recorded over my home in Elkins Park, Montgomery County, PA, on 3rd October 2010 and 3rd October 2011.

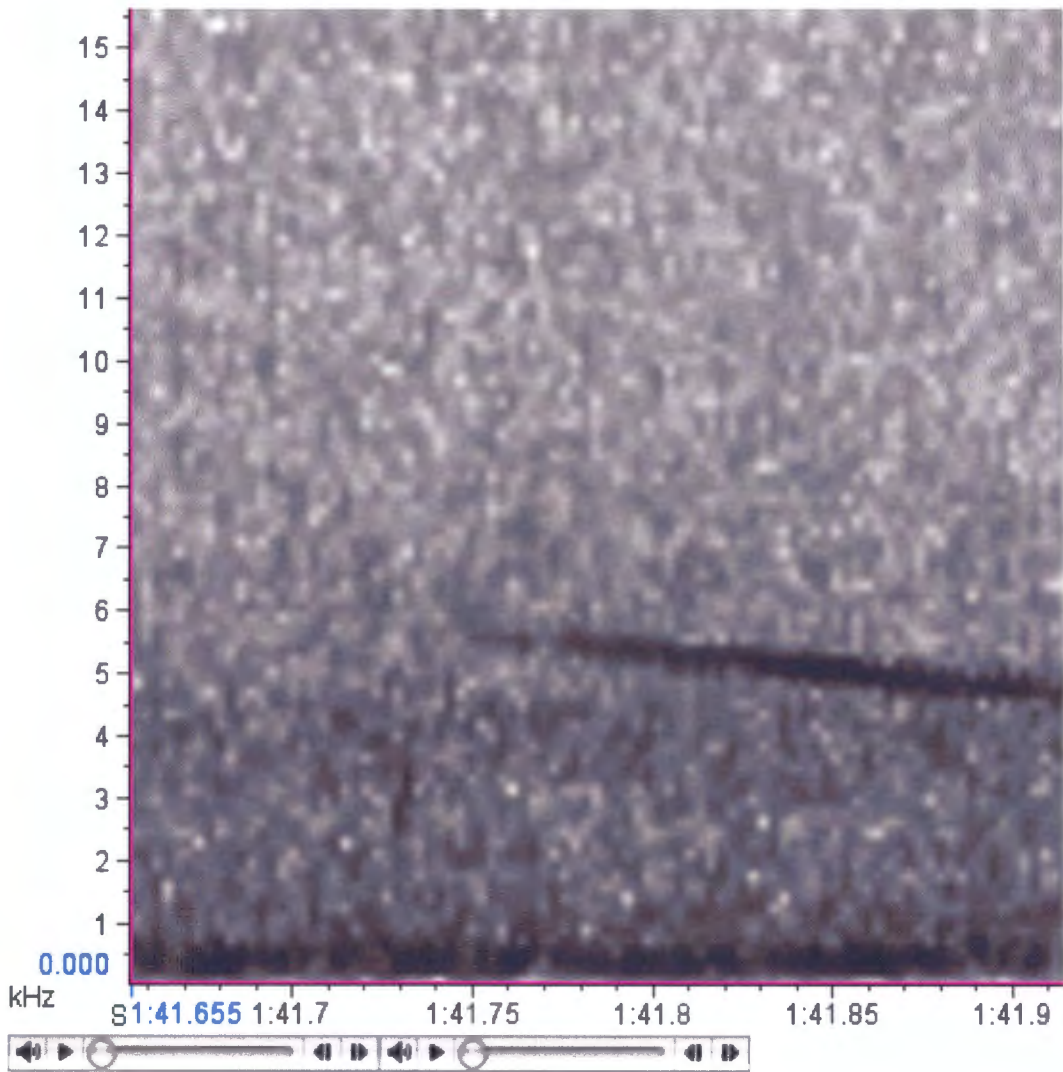

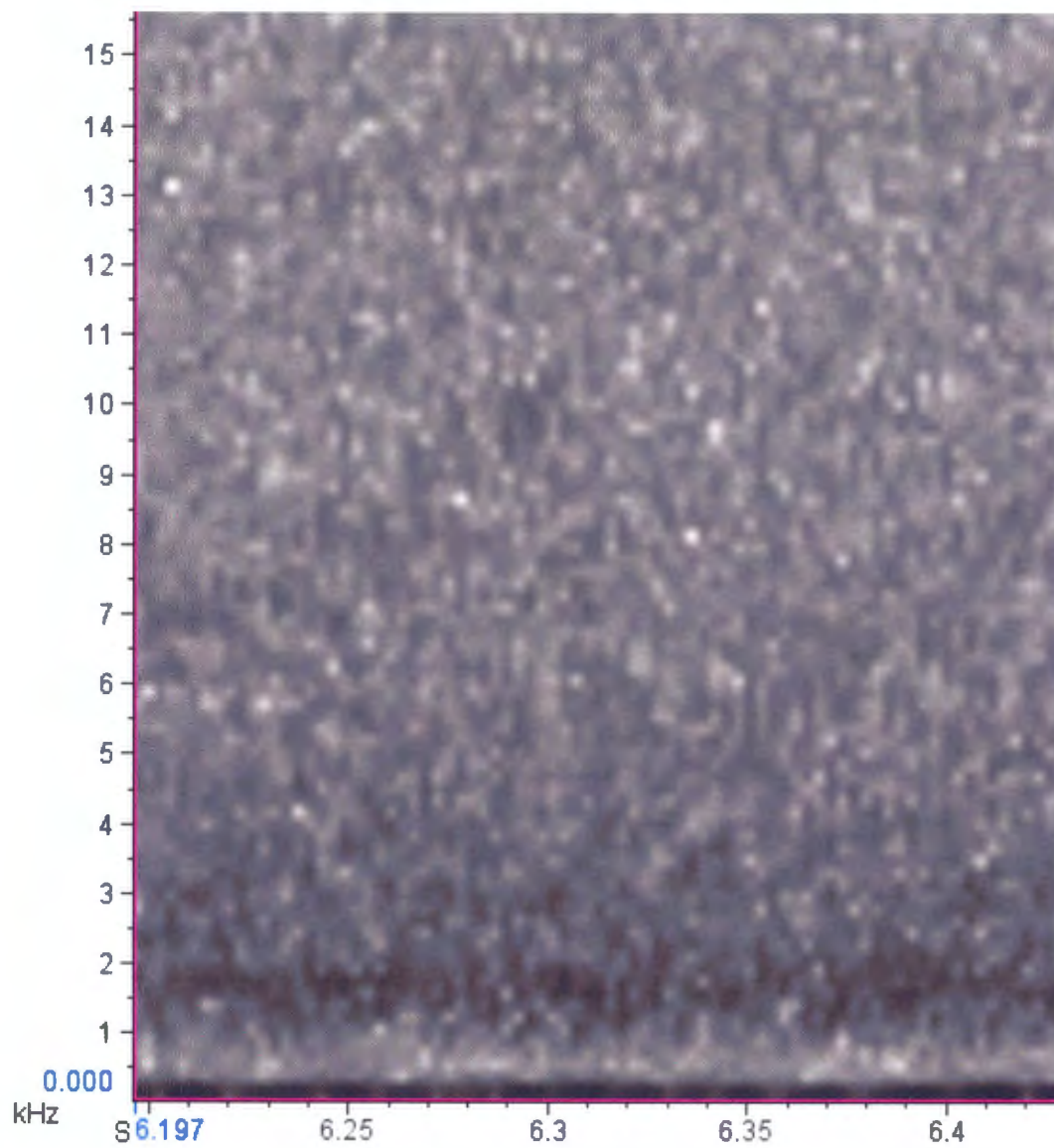
