Description: Randy Stringer reported to me that he had found the remains of a dead Bohemian Waxwing on Pine Tree trail November 26. I could not get to the bird until a few days later, so I was not surprised to find that the bird was gone. However there were a few feathers remaining at the site. Among the the breast and belly feathers I located a single secondary feather. The waxy orange tip on the end of the shaft and the long white patch at the tip of the feather on the outer web confirmed the identity of the waxwing. See photograph.


