



On Sunday October 24, 1993 a LeConte's Sparrow was observed on a grassy island below Bainbridge on the Susquehanna River, Lancaster County, PA. The island had very little dry ground with the reported river level at Harrisburg at 3.9' and rising. (Avery important factor in birding this area) Observers included Skip Conant, ROB MEGRAW and Eric Witner. Observations were made from 230-30'em. One Fairly indistinct photo was taken (500mm). All sightings were made with 10x or less Binoculars in Fairly good light at distances as close as 20 feet.

especially in Fight. A prominant buffy eyeline with a dark crown containing a thin white central crown stripe. The ear patch was a light gray and not outstanding. A very thin eyering was noted (facial skin?) No gray was noted on the nape, only some fine darker streaks. The back was nedium brown with some lighter Streaks and some dark centered feathers with buffy edges. The breast was buffy with some fine streaking continuing along the sides toward the flanks. The belly was white. The bill was dark gray but not black. The legs were pinkish. The tail was medium brown. The tail feathers were pointed

The bird was initially flushed from some waist high grasses and flew about 50' to where it perched in a thicket of River Birch < 8' tall This process continued 4-5 times with the bird diving into the grasses and disappearing.

the bird was unsuccessfully searched for the Following Am
by Jerry Book and Tom Garner, Two Sharptailed Sparrows and adifferent
variety of Birds were noted from the previous day. I am Familiar with the
similar(?) Sharp-tailed sparrow of the Nelson's Race which is a regular localized
late Sept/October migrant of these islands. All three observers saw the
LeContes sparrow at Strubbe Lake Chester Co, PA 18 months before.

If accepted this would be a
first LANCASTER COUNT RECORD.
