Sharp-tailed Sparrow in Crawford County

While birding at Geneva Marshes on Sunday October 8 1988, Mark van der Ven and I located an unusual sparrow with a small group of Song Sparrows (Melospiza melodia) and Swamp Sparrows (M. georgiana) feeding in willows and cattails along the east side of Watson Run Road. After obtaining close views of the bird we identified it as a Sharp-tailed Sparrow, Ammodramus condacutus of the intend races, retsoni.

The bird was noticeably smaller than the accomparying Song and Swamp Sparrows with a much shorter tail and a boldly marked plumage pattern. It had a broad gray certral crown stripe with thinner blackishbrown stripes bordering this and separating it from very pronounced bright buff supercilia. The cheeks and nape were the same shade of groy as the crown, the color extending from the nape around the sides of the neck. The chin, throat and breast were bright buff joined to the supercilian by buff stripes at the rear of the cheeks. There was a small, indistinct central breast spot and indistinct brown streaking at the sides of the breast. The rest of the underparts were pure white with a sharp demaration between the breast and belly. The martle, scapulars and coverts
