al May 1987 on S.G.L. 46 Near Hopeland. The area was off Seglock Rol. near the Horseshae trail. I was turkey hunting at the time so I was in full camo. I was hunting the large clear cut area on top. Not long after light the small birds were active, mostly white throated sparrows. Then 15 ft away a Harris' Sparrow came into view. It was on a brush pile. The bird was very similar to the one I observed in Franklin Co. The black on the face extending down to the breast with the flesh colored bill was the most outstanding field mark. This bird was large the other birds. I watched it few a few minutes then it flew a short distance away.

Mike Gockley the bird club has said he sew a Harris' Sparrow in Lancaster Co. Possibly Middlecreek. You might want to talk to him about that.
