Hi Nick,

Since I couldn't download the PDF file, I'm sending this 'non-form' report for my Harris' Sparrow sighting on 12/22/2001. I'm sure of my sighting; but the short amount of time that the bird was in view will probably cast some doubt with the Records Committee. It should be noted that the bird WAS seen 2 days later by Arlene Koch. At any rate, here's my account of the sighting:

I got a right-facing profile view of the bird, but the main problem was that it only stayed in view for about 10 seconds before flying off down the fencerow.

When I first saw it pop out of the bush 'naked eye', the size and shape gave me the impression that it was probably a White-crowned Sparrow. As soon as I got on it with my 'bins', I first realized that it had a pink bill, and then noticed that it had a white throat patch bordered in black, forming a triangle. The rest of the breast was white. Next, I noticed that the tan-colored head didn't have any noticeably strong markings of any kind. At this point, the bird flew and headed towards the road. I wasn't able to see where it landed, but it did appear to land somewhere near the road. I spent the next hour-and-a-half trying to relocate it, but never did.

At that point, I went back to the car, grabbed a piece of paper, drew a real rough sketch of what I saw, and then grabbed the Sibley guide. All of the features that I was able to see in that short time, were EXACTLY like the picture of the Harris' Sparrow on page 473 and the right-facing profile of the 1st-winter bird shown on page 493.

My impressions of the bird.

Description: A large sparrow.

Size and shape: Very similar to that of a White-crowned Sparrow.

Head: Was only able to notice a plain, tan (or light brown) head with no distinct markings.

Bill: Pinkish, sparrow-like bill.

Throat: White bordered by a fairly thin, triangular, black outline.

Breast: White.

Legs: I wasn't able to observe them in the short time the bird was in view.

Tail: I wasn't able to observe it in the short time the bird was in view

Wings: In the short time the bird was in view, I did not notice any distinct wingbars.

Sounds made, if any: The bird made no sounds of any kind.

Behavior and Habitat: The bird was in a multiflora rose bush in a fencerow surrounded by open fields that contained winter wheat and corn stubble.

Similar Species: The White-crowned Sparrow would be the closest "expected" similar species to what I saw, but was ruled out by the pink bill, plain head with no stripes of any kind, triangular throat patch bordered in black, and light-colored breast.
