While I was editing the spring issue of Pennsylvania Birds, I came across this post regarding a Harris's Sparrow from May on the PA Birds Liserv archives. There was a link to an ebird checklist with photos. The post is below that has details.

Today my wife Barbara and I relocated an adult Harris's Sparrow (found by Dave Hawk on May 6, 2014) near backyard bird feeders of a home along Pohopoco Drive, which runs along the north side of Beltzville State Park. Of interest to me is the fact this bird is only 2.3 miles from last years first county record for this species. Could it be the same bird?? The Harris's Sparrow was with a number of White-crowned Sparrows also feeding on and around the feeders. I wonder if it will stick around or move on with the White-crowned Sparrows.
