Head- bright red-orange more red than orange this same color was also evident on the throat and breast and covered the head to

the nape.

Belly and Flanks- medium green

Back and Wings - overall medium green Undertail Coverts- same red-orange color

No vocalizations heard

It was very active, feeding and flycatching the entire time observed and because of this it would occassionally be hidden in the foliage for several minutes at a time.

Additional notes on the sighting of a Summer Tanager(*Piranga rubra*) at the John Heinz NWR at Tinicum on 24 April 1992

In my original report I failed to mention that the bird was a male in first spring plumage.

Elimination of similar species.

Scarlet Tanager- the bird I saw had uniformly greenish wings as opposed to the black wings of the Scarlet which the male retains in all plumages.

Western Tanager-except for the red-orange areas that I described in the original report, the bird was a medium-green color, not the yellow as in the alternate plumage of the Western male.

Hepatic Tanager- this bird lacked the plumpness that is apparent when first seeing the Hepatic and in fact it had a slim appearance.

Unfortunately I never really got a satisfactory look at the bill to use it as a definitive field mark. Even from the photo enlargement, bill size is hard to determine.

Unfortunately too, the bird remained silent during my observation. Other observers reported that it gave both the song and the call notes of a Summer Tanager, hopefully they will submit a report to P.O.R.C.

My experience with tanagers is 25+ years with both Scarlet and Summer in all plumages. I have seen Western in both basic and alternate plumages in the west. I have seen both sexes of the Hepatic in SE Arizona.

I hope these additional notes will be helpful.
