Enclosed is a rare bird report for Allegheny County. Please note that this description is a **Painted** Bunting from October, 7, 1995.

I read the description in a local publication on natural history in Western Pennsylvania back in October, 1995. I thought it sounded good, but did not know the author, or how to contact him.
