Dear Ted,

Thank you for submitting deatils on the "White-winged" Junco you trapped and banded at your home in Warren, Warren County on 4 April 1994 to P.O.R.C. After careful review and further research, we regret that we are unable to accept this record. The record circulated the committee for two rounds and there was much discussion regarding its identification. The committee felt that the wing chord measurements given in the report (77.5 mm) did not fall within the acceptable wing chord measurements for "White-winged" Junco (83-90 mm) as given in Pyle et al. (1987 Identification Guide to North American Passerines). Most members felt the description was suggestive of a Slate-colored Junco with white wing bars, of which, some members were familiar with from museum specimens.

We hope that this does not discourage you from submitting documentation on any rare birds you find in the future. Please be encouraged to send as much detail as possible.

Dear Committee Members.

I am enclosing slide duplicates and accounts of a laughung gull, Oregon junco, and another junco that resembles a white-winged form.

I was surprised to see that the P.O.R.C. reviewed Oregon junco. They have been recorded on the Warren CBC in 1964, '67, '78, and '81. This one was at Norman Samuelson's house in Sheffield, Warren County, in January, 1973. I don't know the day of the photo, but I do remember the sharp delineation between the black head, neck and breast and the brown back.

The junco with white wing bars was trapped and banded at my home on the edge of Warren on April 4, 1994. My notes say that it was "dark gray with 3 or 4 greater wing coverts and 5 or 6 middle wing orown on the back and more than $2\frac{1}{2}$ outer white tail feathers on each side". The wing chord measured 77.5 mm., which the Bird Banding Office considereds sex unknown. By 3 or 4 wing coverts and 5 or 6. The state of there were 3 or one of the state of the sta tail feathers means that the third was not completely white.

> On April 11, 1994, another junco that was similar except that one less covert in each bar was white-tipped, and the wing chord was 79mm., which is considered a male. I did not note any brown on it. Neither bird was recaptured.

I submitted my banding report on these as slate-colored juncoes along with my notes (no photo), and have not received any reply about it. Either they agree or did not really review it. I'll be very interested in your conclusion.
